DEAR LAURIE HILLBILLY FAIR CRAFT & COMMERCIAL VENDOR:

It's time again to let you know about the upcoming Laurie Hillbilly Fair to be held at the Laurie Fairgrounds, September 15TH & 16TH.

Spaces inside the commercial tent will be limited to 14-10 X 10 spaces. Craft tent spaces will be limited to 12-10X10; so it will be on a first come, first serve basis. You may exhibit, demonstrate and sell your items. There will be electricity available in these tents at no additional charge. Outside vendors please specify on your application the size from 10 X 10 or larger outdoor spaces needed and specify if electricity is required for an additional fee.

Exhibitors may set up Thursday, September 14th from 12:00pm to 6:00pm. or Friday morning from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. All exhibitors must check in at the information booth (LOG CABIN) before setting up. All exhibitors are expected to be set up and ready for business by 3:00 pm Friday, September 15th. Exhibits should be open from 3:00 pm until 7:00 pm on Friday and 9:00 am until 7:00 pm on Saturday. You may stay open later in the evenings, if you wish. Due to activities going on until midnight, you may not operate vehicles on the fairgrounds until after closing on Saturday night.

All vehicles, wagons and trailers must be in exhibitors parking area by opening time each day unless prior arrangements have been made. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SORRY, NO DOGS ALLOWED IN FAIRGROUNDS

Check your application for amount of space rent you will owe (depending on the size required). The space rent includes two parking passes. If additional passes are needed, please include \$4.00 for each additional pass. This pass is good for both days. Parking lots will be marked for exhibitors. Camping sites are available for \$20.00 for three (3) nights. This includes electricity, water and dumping station.

DEMONSTRATIONS: We would like to emphasize that, if at all possible, craft people demonstrate their skills and talents by working at their crafts. It has been proven that most fair-goers are interested in seeing artisans at work and this serves to draw more people to your booth and to increase your sales. If you would consider demonstrating your skills at your booth, please so indicate on your contract and briefly explain what you would be doing.
