

**PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
BOARD OF ALDERMEN
AUGUST 14, 2018 5:30 P.M.
CITY OF LAURIE, MISSOURI**

Mayor Allen Kimberling called the hearing to order at 5:30 p.m.

Present at the meeting were Mayor Allen Kimberling, Aldermen: Carol Gill, Karen Dobbins, Jeff Chorpening, Herb Keck

Others present were City Clerk Ron Clarke, City Attorney Andrew Renken, Dick Dobbins, Doug Gill, Ron Holst, and Vanessa Hebrank

Mayor Kimberling stated the purpose of the hearing is to obtain public comments and questions related to the City of Laurie Transportation Enhancement Master Plan aka the Sidewalk Master Plan.

City Clerk Clarke reported that Phase 5A had already been chosen by the Board after the last Public Hearing in July, 2017 and that a map and cost estimates were available at the back of the room.

Ron Holst asked if Phase 5B could be completed if the City decided they wanted to include it. City Clerk Clarke reported it would most likely be included as an add alternate in the final proposal, but that the cost of the crosswalk was prohibitive. Mr. Holst asked what that cost was. City Clerk Clarke reported the current estimate for Phase 5B was \$82,093.

Doug Gill asked if the State should pay for the crosswalk as it was a State Highway. Mr. Clarke said we could explore that possibility during the approval stage.

Alderman Dobbins made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing. Hearing adjourned at 5:58 pm.
